Richard Graf von Waldburg zu Wolfegg und Waldsee, German citizen, born in 1965, completed his bachelor's degree in economics and geography at the University of London (UCL) in 1990. He then became managing partner of WAKOM in Dresden until 1992.

From 1993 to 1995, Richard Waldburg worked as an assistant to the management at Hoecherl Holding GmbH in Munich. This was followed by studies at the IESE in Barcelona, which he completed in 1997 with a Master of Business Administration. Until 1999, he was an Associate in the Corporate Finance Department of Dresdner Kleinwort Benson in London. From 1999 to 2016, he was first Vice-President (M & A Advisory) at Lazard Ltd. in Frankfurt am Main, after which he worked as a Director of Kuna & Co GmbH and Senior Advisor to its legal successor Evercore GmbH in Frankfurt am Main.

Since 2014, he has been managing partner of Basic Research GmbH in Munich or its portfolio companies; since 2016, he has also been managing director (M & A consulting) of Waldburg Advisors GmbH in Munich. He is still active in these positions today.
