

## Susanne Heckelsberger



Susanne Heckelsberger, German citizen, born in 1964, studied business administration at the University of Mannheim and graduated with a degree in business administration. In parallel with her work in the auditing sector at KPMG and GKT Industrie- und Handelstreuhand, she then successfully passed the examinations to become both a tax consultant and an auditor.

In 1998 she took over the management of the balance sheet department of the listed mechanical engineering group AGIV AG, before she became managing director of the auditing company Dr. Rödl Stuttgart GmbH in 2000. In 2003, Ms. Heckelsberger started as Head of Group Auditing at mg technologies (GEA Group) and was Chief Financial Officer of Zimmer AG (GEA Group) from 2005. Subsequently, she took over the Chief Operation Officer function at Allianz Capital Partners from 2008 to 2010.

From 2015 to 2019, Ms. Heckelsberger held the position of CFO at the s.Oliver Group in Rottendorf. From 2010 to 2015 and since 2020, Ms. Heckelsberger has worked as a management consultant and interim manager in Stuttgart. She advises companies on topics of digitalization, corporate transformation and on the establishment of adequate corporate governance systems, also taking sustainability aspects into account.

Susanne Heckelsberger has been a member of the Supervisory Board of Villeroy & Boch AG since 2020. She has been a member of the Supervisory Board of Vitesco Technologies AG, Regensburger, since 2021. In both bodies, she chairs the Audit Committee.
