

**Prof. Annette G. Köhler**



Prof. Annette G. Köhler, German citizen, born in 1967, studied business and economics at the universities of Augsburg and Detroit (USA). She subsequently earned her doctorate at the Faculty of Management, Economics and Social Sciences of the University of Cologne.

Parallel to this, Prof. Annette G. Köhler worked as a research assistant at the Ifo Institute for Economic Research from 1993 to 1997. She then went on to work for Mummert + Partner Unternehmensberatung. In 1998 she became a research assistant to the Chair of Auditing and Accounting at the University of Wuppertal. In 2003 she joined the University of Ulm as a research assistant, where she also qualified as a university lecturer. In the period from 2004 to 2005 she was Professor of Business Administration at the Leipzig Graduate School of Management before accepting a professorship at the University of Duisburg-Essen, where she is also the Chair of Accounting, Auditing and Controlling. Her main areas of research include international corporate governance and auditing.

Prof. Annette G. Köhler has been a member of the Supervisory Board of HVB UniCredit Bank AG since 2014 and that of DMG Mori AG since 2017. She also heads the German Academic Association for Business Research's "Good Professional Practice" working group and the Scientific Advisory Board of the German Institute of Internal Auditors. Moreover, Prof. Annette G. Köhler is a member of the "External and Internal Corporate Control" working group at Schmalenbach-Gesellschaft für Betriebswirtschaftslehre and General Secretary of the European Auditing Research Network.
