

Dietmar Geuskens



Dietmar Geuskens, a German national who was born in 1960, completed an apprenticeship as an electronics engineer at RAG Aktiengesellschaft Essen from 1977 to 1980, where he worked until 1987 and served both as youth spokesman and an employee representative.

From 1987 to 1988 he trained as a trade union secretary at the academy of work (Akademie der Arbeit) at the University of Frankfurt am Main. In this capacity, Dietmar Geuskens subsequently worked for the IG BCE Saarbrücken trade union with a focus on legal/litigation. In 2006 he took over the district management of IG BCE for the district of Saarbrücken.

Dietmar Geuskens has been a member of the supervisory board of Villeroy & Boch AG since 2007.

In addition, he is a member of the board of directors of the Saarland employment agency (Agentur für Arbeit Saarland), a member of the energy council and the state government's Saar community initiative (Saargemeinschaftsinitiative), as well as a member of the management board of the Saarland chamber of employment (Arbeitskammer des Saarlandes).
