Werner Jäger, a German national who was born in 1956, completed an apprenticeship as an offset printer from 1972 to 1975.

He has been employed by Villeroy & Boch AG in a commercial capacity since 1976. Between 1976 and 1986, he supported the tableware division and then the sanitaryware and tile divisions with regard to central IT, before becoming an IT administrator at Group headquarters and working in the commercial administration in 1986. He also served as deputy head of IT for production before leaving the central IT department.

Werner Jäger was elected to the head office works council in 1989. From 2000 to 2009, he served as deputy chairman of the head office works council. In 2009, he was elected to the position of chairman of the head office works council and released from all other responsibilities. He is also a member of the economic committee, the central works council and the European works council.

Since 2007, Werner Jäger has been a member of the supervisory board and serves on its audit committee.

He also serves as an honorary judge at the labour court (Arbeitsgericht) in Saarlouis.
