Thomas Scherer, German citizen, born in 1969, completed an apprenticeship as a wholesale and export merchant.

Following on from this, Mr Scherer worked as a warehouse clerk/picker at Markant in Wadern from 1991 to 1994. He began his professional career at Villeroy & Boch as a picker in the Losheim/Saar distribution centre in 1999. He held this position until 2010, at which time he transferred to shipping management, where he remained until 2018.

Mr Scherer joined the Bathroom and Wellness Works Council of Villeroy & Boch AG as early as 2003. At the same time, he studied part-time at ASW Berufsakademie des Saarlandes to qualify as a logistics administrator. As the Deputy Chairman of the Bathroom and Wellness Works Council, Mr Scherer has been released from his other work duties since March 2018. He became both the Chairman of the Bathroom and Wellness Works Council and the Chairman of the European Works Council in February 2020.
